"Within the corporate market, Blackberry is still an important player and we need to make sure we are offering versions for as many of our clients as possible." says Long.

As the team building experience continues to evolve for corporate groups, Scavenger Hunt Anywhere continues examine how its clients use their phones throughout their exercise and incorporate new ideas that both entertain participants and challenge their problem-solving skills.
